Payments are made via a secure payment platform called *Stripe* which offers clients the options of paying by debit card, credit card, or *PayPal*.

- Before the first tutoring session, the client will complete student/family registration form, read and sign the Tutoring Contract,
- Then proceed to the secure payment platform *Stripe* and fill in credit/debit card details.
